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#### **ADDENDUM: COVID-19**

The information that follow is a temporary amendment to the Behaviour and Rewards policy to take into account the short term changes that need to be in place during the Covid-19 pandemic 2020. It takes into account the school risk assessment and DFE guidance for the wider opening of secondary schools from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.

Above all everyone must be kind and considerate towards others at all times. We recognise that COVID19 is an unprecedented situation and many people will feel anxious and worried. Students should make sure that they speak to an adult if they need help or support.

#### Uniform:

- Students should not wear ties or blazers. Uniform should consist of clean black trousers or school skirt, a white shirt and black shoes.
- No jewellery, wrist watches, bracelets or rings can be worn. Make-up / lip balms should not be brought to school.
- Clean clothes should be worn and bagged and washed on arrival at home.
- Students must bring a packed lunch, a filled water bottle and their own school equipment. This must NOT be shared with other students. There will be no access to the water fountain.
- Mobile phones must be switched off and out of sight at all times.

#### **General expectations of students:**

- Students should not come to school if they or someone in their household has symptoms of Covid 19.
- Students should not walk / cycle to or from school in groups.
- Students must maintain social distancing on the journey to and from school. Not distancing in the community is against Public Health advice and will affect everyone.
- Public transport should be minimised students should walk / cycle to and from school.
- Students must ALL wash their hands on arrival.
- Students must follow instructions regarding hand washing at all times.

**Note:** Hands must be washed in accordance with current government guidance.

#### Around the School:

- We expect students to be CLEAR as we would at any other time. See main behaviour policy P4
- Students should not move from their allocated pod / zone except for break and lunch time. They must then remain in their designated areas.
- Students should only use the bathrooms allocated to their pod.
- Students must follow the one- way system at all times and use the dedicated external exit.
- Students must follow 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' and allow cleaning to take place as required.
- Students can wear face coverings but these are not compulsory. This may change according government advice.
- Students must tell a member of staff if they feel ill at any time.

#### **Classroom Expectations:**

- The classroom stages have been amended for the period of Covid19:
- Stage one friendly warning
- Stage two time out with SLT to discuss
- Stage three time out with SLT plus phone call home
- Stage four removal from 'face to face' provision and return to remote learning

#### **Classroom Rewards:**

Students who are working at home can be rewarded for their work through the 'Home Heroes' award. Nominations can be sent to <a href="mailto:Homeheroes@wbvs.co.uk">Homeheroes@wbvs.co.uk</a>.

Year 10 Students receiving face to face support at school or in the key worker category can be awarded GOALS in the normal way. Positive feedback can also be given to recognise a positive attitude to learning and/or effort on Google Classroom.
