Poland Trip 1 - 4 July 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am very pleased to inform you that your child has a place on the Poland Trip in July 2024. The total cost of the trip will be £630.00. To secure this place we will require a non refundable deposit of £200.00 by Tuesday 7 November 2023.

The remaining balance can then be paid in instalments as follows, 2nd Instalment of £86.00 to be paid by Thursday 7 December 2023, 3rd Instalment of £86.00 to be paid by Monday 8 January 2024, 4th instalment of £86.00 to be paid by Wednesday 7 February 2024, 5th instalment to be paid by Thursday 7 March 2024 and the final instalment of £86.00 to be paid by Monday 8 April 2024.

All payments should be made through your ParentPay account. If your child does not want to go on the trip please inform us as soon as possible so we can offer their place to another child.
