Paris Trip 1 – 5 July 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am very pleased to inform you that your child has a place on the Paris Trip in July 2024. The total cost of the trip will be **£655.00**. To secure this place we will require a non refundable deposit of **£70 by 7 December 2023**.

The remaining balance can then be paid in instalments as follows, **2nd instalment of £150 by 12 Jan 2024**, **3rd Instalment of £150 by 12 Feb 2024**, **4th instalment of £150 by 12 March 2024** and a **final instalment of £135 by the 12 April 2024**.

All payments should be made through your ParentPay account. If your child does not want to go on the trip please inform us as soon as possible and before the deposit deadline date so we can offer their place to another child.

We will be using a company called **WST** part of the 'next generation travel group' they have over 400 years' combined experience in the educational visits market.
