Community Week – 01 July to 05 July 2024

Last years introduction of Sustainability week was a roaring success! So much so, we are doing the whole thing again! However, this time instead of a focus on sustainability, we will turn our attention to something equally important: community. The week will give students the opportunity to experience something new, but also develop key character traits that will support them long after their journey through school.

The week will involve the school timetable being collapsed and students following a programme of different activities for the week instead. It will not only give students the opportunity to make lasting memories with their friends, but also allow them opportunities to think about the importance of community.

The week is for year 7, 8 and 9 students and will run from **Monday 01 July 2024 to Friday 05 July 2024**. We have organised multiple residential trips, out of school trips and school-based activities for students to choose from. **All students will also participate in a whole-school Community Day on Friday 05 July 2024**, focused on raising money for a local charity. Details of the day will be sent out closer to the time.

Students have already been presented with information about Community Week in their assemblies. We ask that parents/guardians discuss the selection of activities (on the next page) with their child. All students will select their activities choices during tutor time, during the week beginning **Monday 12 February 2024**. They will be asked to choose up to 4 trips and 4 school-based activities, they will then be allocated a mixture for the week. Students do not have to choose any trips if they do not wish to.

Once numbers have been confirmed, students will be allocated activities. Details of which activities they will be participating in will be shared and payments will then be placed on ParentPay. A £10.00 deposit will be required to secure each trip. For example, if you child is allocated 3 trips, we would expect a deposit of £30.00. Details of all deposit and payment deadlines will be communicated in due course, as soon as numbers have been finalised.

If no payment is made or no contact has been made regarding financial support by the deadline, your child will be removed from their chosen activities and allocated school-based activities instead.
