Dear Parent/Carer

We are currently planning a Ski Trip for 2026. The trip will take place during the first week of the Easter holidays. Actual dates are to be confirmed once we have flight details but it will be the **28 or 29 March 2026**. The trip will be open to current year 8 and current year 9 students.

We will be going to Italy to ski in the Alps at the resort of Santa Caterina, which is one of the highest ski resorts in Italy. The trip includes the following:

- Local coach pick up from school and return transfer to airport, return flights to Italy to include 20kg hold luggage.
- 6 nights full board accommodation.
- 5 day lift pass
- 5 day hire of skis, boots, helmet and poles (cost of any other clothing not included)
- 5 x 4 hour ski lessons
- Fully comprehensive travel and medical insurance
- Evening activities which may include, tobogganing, disco, karaoke, pizza nights and café visits.

The trip will be organised by Ski and Sport Travel Group who have been arranging school trips for over 40 years and are fully ATOL protected. You can find out more by going to <https://www.skiandsporttravel.co.uk>

**The basic cost for this trip will be approximately £1250.00.**

If you would like your child to be included on the school ski trip, please log into **ParentPay** and pay a deposit of £200 by **Thursday 31 October 2024**. If there is sufficient interest, the booking can be confirmed and you will be given definite details of the final cost of the trip. If your child does not get a place the deposit will be refunded. Unfortunately, once payments have been made by us to confirm the booking (unless covered by the Insurance Policy) we will be unable to make any refunds unless another student takes the place. All students will have an equal opportunity to attend a residential trip. We may use a random generator if a trip is oversubscribed and we may limit students to one trip across a two year period.
