Year 8 Paris Trip 30 June – 04 July 2025

We are very excited to inform you that we will be organizing a trip to Paris – France next year. The trip will include the following:

- Return transport via coach/ferry/channel tunnel from the school
- Full board accommodation (3 nights full board, 1 night half board)
- Visit to Disneyland Paris
- Visit to the Centre Pompidou
- Visit to the Palace of Versailles
- Visit to Montmartre and Sacre Coeur
- Visit to Musee D Orsay

The cost of this trip will be approximately **£710**, this will be payable in instalments.

If you would like your child to be included on the Paris trip, please log into **ParentPay** and pay a deposit of £200 by **Thursday 31 October 2024**. If there is sufficient interest, the booking can be confirmed and you will be given definite details of the final cost of the trip including instalment dates. If your child does not get a place the deposit will be refunded. Unfortunately, once payments have been made by us to confirm the booking (unless covered by the Insurance Policy) we will be unable to make any refunds unless another student takes the place. All students will have an equal opportunity to attend a residential trip. We may use a random generator if a trip is oversubscribed and we may limit students to one trip across a two year period.
