## Year 9 Krakow Residential 29 June – 03 July 2026

We are very excited to share with you, the details of the Y9 annual trip to Krakow – Poland next year. The trip will include the following:

- Airport transfers
- Return flights from Birmingham Airport
- Half board accommodation (lunches will not be included)
- Visit to the following:
  - Auschwitz Birkenau
  - Wieliczka Salt Mine
  - Walking tour of Krakow
  - St Mary's Basilica
  - Galicia Museum
  - Jewish Quarter

The cost of this trip will be approximately **£770**, this will be payable in instalments. If you would like your child to be included on the Krakow trip, please log into **ParentPay** and pay a deposit of £100 by **Monday 22 September 2025**. If there is sufficient interest, the booking can be confirmed and you will be given definite details of the final cost of the trip including instalment dates. If the demand exceeds the number of places available, the places will be drawn at random. If your child does not get a place the deposit will be refunded. Unfortunately, once payments have been made by us to confirm the booking (unless covered by the Insurance Policy) we will be unable to make any refunds unless another student takes the place. Your child will require their own passport to travel on this trip, so please bear this in mind when making your decision.
