ADMISSIONS CONSULTATION FOR WOODBROOK VALE SCHOOL

Woodbrook Vale School is seeking your views on the changes proposed below. Our consultation will run for six weeks from **30 October 2018 to 10 December 2018**. The determined admissions arrangements must be published on our website by 15 March 2019.

We are required to consult about our arrangements at least every 7 years.

We believe that this policy meets the needs of our community.

This policy will operate for school entry in September 2020. It will also apply to all mid-term admissions for the school year 2020/2021 and for subsequent years until further notice.

We are proposing to make minor changes to two elements of the over subscription criteria in the policy. These are set out below along with the proposed changes. No other changes are proposed to any criteria, definitions or measuring procedures.

Current Admissions Arrangements:

- 3. Children living permanently in the Woodbrook Vale catchment area. The catchment area has the same boundaries as the catchment areas of Woodbrook Vale's feeder primary schools:
 - Holywell Primary School
 - Mountfields Lodge Primary School
 - Outwoods Edge Primary School
 - The Beacon Academy

A map is available at the end of this policy.

4. Children currently attending a **feeder primary school** (listed in 3 above) who do not live in the catchment area.

It is proposed to amend the above criteria with the following:

- 3. Children living permanently in the Woodbrook Vale **catchment area**. A map is available at the end of this policy.
- 4. Children currently attending a **feeder primary school** who do not live in the catchment area. The designated feeder schools are:
 - Holywell Primary School
 - Mountfields Lodge Primary School
 - Outwoods Edge Primary School
 - The Beacon Academy

The trustees will then consider all responses before making a final decision.
